J. WALTER PORTER FELLOWSHIP 2010-2011

The J. Walter Porter Memorial Fund was established in 1978 to finance **annual fellowships for graduate study and/or research in Water Resources Engineering** to individuals who demonstrate outstanding ability and promise of excellence in engineering.

A stipend of \$2,000 associated with the Fellowship shall be considered as a gift to the recipient. **The recipient shall be a member of Texas Section, ASCE at the time of application, and the graduate study and/or research must be done in Texas.** Other obligations include filing a short formal report with the Trustees at the conclusion of the academic year, and preparing a paper on the results of the study and/or research for possible presentation at a regular meeting of the Texas Section. The stipend will be paid quarterly for a twelve-month period beginning September 1, 2010.

One Fellowship will be awarded this year. Applications will be obtainable from the Civil Engineering Departments of the various Texas Engineering Colleges after February 1, 2010, or may be obtained directly from the Trustees Secretary-Treasurer. Applications are due to the Secretary-Treasurer by April 15, 2010.
